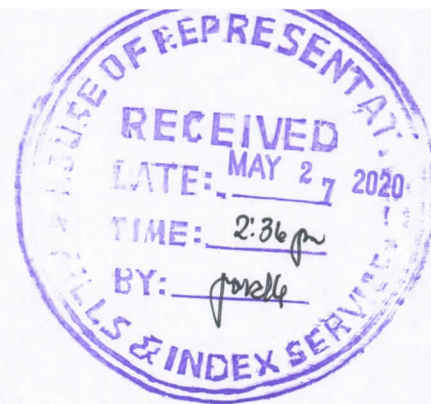

**AN ACT AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 7305,  
OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE MAGNA CARTA OF PUBLIC HEALTH WORKERS,  
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

*Be it enacted by the House of Representatives and Senate of the Congress assembled:*

**SECTION 1.** There shall be an additional provision of R.A. 7305, otherwise known as the Magna Carta of Public Health Workers, to read as follows:

**SECTION 29. EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE TO DIRECT DESCENDANT/BENEFICIARIES OF COVID-19 HEROES. – ALL PUBLIC HEALTH WORKERS WHO DIED DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC SHALL BE ENTITLED TO ONE DIRECT DESCENDANT/BENEFICIARY, UPON CERTIFICATION OF THE HEALTH SECRETARY, BE ADMITTED TO ANY SCHOOL, COLLEGE, UNIVERSITY, OR INSTITUTION AUTHORIZED BY THE GOVERNMENT, WITH ALL SCHOOL FEES, INCLUDING TUITION, MATRICULATION, ATHLETIC, LIBRARY, LABORATORY, MEDICAL, MILITARY TRAINING, DIPLOMA AND GRADUATION FEES, AT THE EXPENSE OF THE GOVERNMENT, SUBJECT TO RULES AND CONDITIONS PROMULGATED BY THE HEALTH SECRETARY.”**

**SECTION 2.** This Act shall take effect after fifteen days (15) following its publication in at least two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
