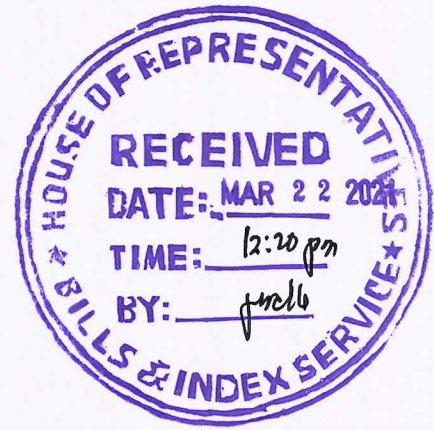

EXPLANATORY NOTE

By virtue of Republic Act. No. 8471, the three municipalities of Babak, Samal, and Kaputian of Samal Island, Province of Davao, was constituted into a component city known as the Island Garden City of Samal (IGACOS).

On March 7, 1998, Republic Act No. 8471 was ratified by two-third votes of the registered voters in a plebiscite called for such purpose. Since the ratification, the City Government of the Island Garden City of Samal has been annually commemorating the day of the plebiscite through several fun-filled activities.

Hence, the declaration of March 7 of every year as a special non-working holiday for the annual commemoration of the day of the plebiscite of the Island Garden City of Samal (IGACOS) is necessary.

In view of the foregoing, the immediate passage of this bill is earnestly sought.

**AN ACT DECLARING MARCH 7 OF EVERY YEAR AS A SPECIAL NON-WORKING
HOLIDAY IN THE ISLAND GARDEN CITY OF SAMAL (IGACOS), PROVINCE OF DAVAO
DEL NORTE IN COMMEMORATION OF ITS FOUNDING ANNIVERSARY**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. March 7 of every year is hereby declared as a special non-working holiday in the Island Garden City of Samal, Province of Davao del Norte.

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
