EXPLANATORY NOTE

This measure proposes that April 4 of every year be declared as a special nonworking holiday in the City of Antipolo, in commemoration of its Cityhood Anniversary.

From its humble beginnings as a municipality, Antipolo has indeed come a long way with its growth and development rapidly increasing following its conversion into a component city of the Province of Rizal in 1998.

Classified as a first class component city based on income, Antipolo has been officially designated as the capital of Rizal Province, a development that is seen to further promote progress.

This measure is seen to provide Antipolo not only with the recognition it deserves, but also an opportunity for Antipoleños to realize and celebrate the immense potential of their city.

In view of the foregoing, immediate passage of this bill is earnestly sought.

**AN ACT DECLARING APRIL 4 OF EVERY YEAR AS A SPECIAL NON-WORKING
HOLIDAY IN THE CITY OF ANTIPOLO, PROVINCE OF RIZAL, IN
COMMEMORATION OF ITS CITYHOOD ANNIVERSARY**

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. April 4 of every year is declared a special nonworking holiday in the City of Antipolo, Province of Rizal to commemorate its Cityhood Anniversary.

SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
