RESOLUTION

FOR THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES TO URGE THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE (PNP)
TO THOROUGHLY REVIEW ITS RANKS, ITS SYSTEM AS WELL AS ITS RULES AND COME OUT
WITH COMPREHENSIVE RECOMMENDATIONS TO REFORM THIS IMPORTANT
INSTITUTION.

WHEREAS, the recent gruesome murder of 15-year old Ilocos Sur native Fabila Pineda right after she had filed a criminal complaint of molestation in Cabugao against one of the 2 police suspects in her killing, namely Police Staff Sergeants Randy Ramos and Marawi Torda of the San Juan Police Station in Ilocos Sur has horrified the people in that region;

WHEREAS, the allegation that the 2 suspects: PO3 Marawi Torda had committed Acts of Lasciviousness against Pineda and PO3 Randy Ramos had raped Pineda's cousin prior to Pineda's murder has stoked fears and distrust among the people against law enforcers;

WHEREAS, the security of the residents and the peace and order situation in that locality seems to be at grave risk as there is an impression that the very people that have sworn to protect and serve the citizenry have now become the law breakers;

WHEREAS, Ilocos Sur Police Chief Colonel Ronald Tagao announced that he will replace the entire police personnel in San Juan and Cabugao and have them undergo retraining;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED FOR THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, TO URGE THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE (PNP) TO THOROUGHLY REVIEW ITS RANKS, ITS SYSTEM AS WELL AS ITS RULES AND COME OUT WITH COMPREHENSIVE RECOMMENDATIONS TO REFORM THIS IMPORTANT INSTITUTION.
