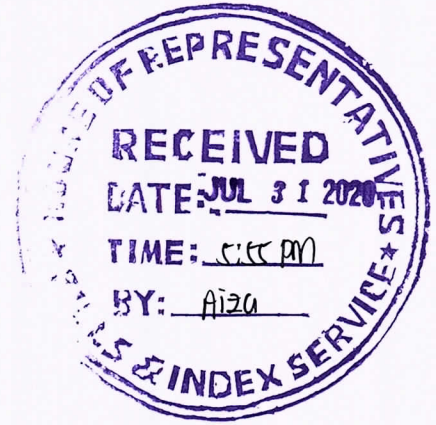

RESOLUTION

FOR THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES TO CALL OUT TO THE VARIOUS GOVERNMENT AGENCIES DURING THIS PANDEMIC AND ECONOMIC CRISIS TO INTERVENE IN GENERATING EMPLOYMENT THROUGH ACTIVE LABOR MARKET PROGRAMS (ALMPs)

WHEREAS, Active Labor Market Programs (ALMPs) have been used in several countries in response to conditions that caused or may result in vast unemployment, reduction in wages and increase in poverty;

WHEREAS, ALMPs are policy interventions in the demand side of the labor market intended to assist enterprises to increase jobs through direct employment programs or by providing incentives for creating or retaining employment;

WHEREAS, ALMPs are also supply side interventions for those in the labor force such as programs intended for human capital enhancement, labor market matching and in-work benefits such as tax credits and public works;

WHEREAS, these ALMPs in the Philippines have mostly targeted the poor, marginalized or vulnerable households or communities wherein these projects include direct employment through public works or self-employment development, employment facilitation and human resource development;


WHEREAS, there are several national agencies that implement ALMP such as the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI); the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE); the Department of Agrarian Reform (DAR); the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD); the Department of Transportation (DoTr); the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH); the Department of Agriculture (DA) and the Department of Tourism (DoT);

WHEREAS, some of these projects are the DTI's financing of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) through the Small Business Guarantee Fund Corporation (SBGFC); the

DSWD's livelihood projects for PANTAWID beneficiaries; the DA's AFMA and the DPWH's Out-of-School Youth toward Economic Recovery (OYSTER) Program.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED FOR THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, to call out to the various government agencies during this pandemic and economic crisis to intervene in generating employment through Active Labor Market Programs (ALMPs).
