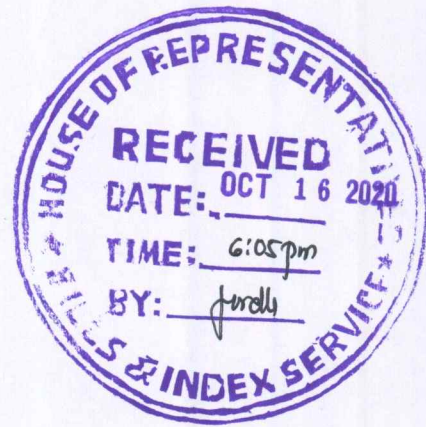

**A RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, Honorable Alfredo G. Marañon Jr. passed away last October 1, 2020 at the age of eighty-four (84) due to complications associated with his cardiac health;

**WHEREAS**, he was a loving husband to his wife Dr. Marilyn Dalisay Marañon, and a caring father to his children Todd and Anna Marie McConchie, Armand and Aileen Lontoc, Alfredo III and Fe Marañon, Takayuki and Agnes Iida, Patrick and Carmela Valderrama, Anthony and Cathy Marañon, and Arthur and Charisse Marañon;

**WHEREAS**, Hon. Marañon led a life devoted to genuine public service spanning more than five decades, dating back to 1964 where he started as a municipal councilor of Sagay;

**WHEREAS**, he went on to become a vice mayor and the mayor of Sagay City, and later on served as an assemblyman of Negros Occidental and the Representative of the Second District of Negros Occidental during the 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, and 12<sup>th</sup> Congresses'

**WHEREAS**, Hon. Marañon also led the Negros Occidental province as governor for three terms, from 2010 to 2019;

**WHEREAS**, during his first term as the governor of the province, he implemented the Negros First! Development plan which aimed to optimize the resources of the province for agricultural production with the goal to achieve food security and generating opportunities for the poor and marginalized;

**WHEREAS**, Gov. Marañon was also an aquaculturist with a passion for protecting the environment and for organic agriculture—among his environmental advocacies were the protection of the Visayan Triangle and the use of renewable energy;

**WHEREAS**, Gov. Marañon also led the establishment of the Sagay Marine Reserve which is among the province's 42 marine protected areas and 10 coastal communities which was declared as Wetlands of International Importance;

**WHEREAS**, in his nine-year stint as Governor of Negros Occidental, he truly has done a lot for the to help and improve the quality of life of the people of the province;


