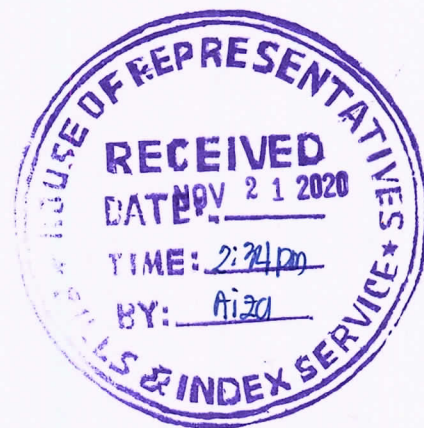

A RESOLUTION

EXPRESSING THE PROFOUND SYMPATHIES AND SINCEREST CONDOLENCES OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES TO THE BEREAVED FAMILY OF HONORABLE RAUL V. DEL MAR, REPRESENTATIVE OF THE FIRST DISTRICT OF CEBU CITY IN THE EIGHTH, NINTH, TENTH, TWELFTH, THIRTEENTH, FOURTEENTH, SIXTEENTH, SEVENTEENTH, AND EIGHTEENTH CONGRESSES

WHEREAS, Honorable Raul V. Del Mar, incumbent Representative of the First District of Cebu City, passed away last November 17, 2020 at the age of seventy-nine;

WHEREAS, Representative Del Mar is survived by wife Melanie and his children Raoul and former Cebu City congresswoman Rachel "Cutie" del Mar;

WHEREAS, Congressman Del Mar has served as the Representative of 1st Cebu City for nine (9) terms in which he authored numerous house measures which aimed to help and improve the quality of life of Cebuanos;

WHEREAS, Rep. Del Mar was a staunch advocate for the rights, safety and welfare of Journalists;

WHEREAS, In the 17th Congress, Rep. Del Mar sponsored the house measure seeking to expand the coverage of exemptions on revealing the source of published news or information obtained in confidence to include journalist from broadcast and news agencies, which was later on enacted into Republic Act No. 11458;


