WHEREAS, Lupo Alava passed away at the age of 63 due to complications from COVID-19;

WHEREAS, he was survived by his wife Gertrude Alava and his three children—Seynth, Sylvester, and Genevieve;

WHEREAS, Alava had been an active professional cyclist until 1985. In 1980 he was the Marlboro Tour of Luzon's Rookie of the Year awardee, the Tour ng Pilipinas 1980 first lap winner, and overall champion in the Mindanao and Visayas laps and eighth in the finals nationwide;

WHEREAS, he served as the past president of the Presidential Cycling Federation;


