WHEREAS, Honorable Douglas "Dogo" R.A. Cagas, passed away on the 10th of June 2021 at the age of 77, after having suffered from COVID-19 complications;

WHEREAS, he was a loving husband to incumbent Davao Del Sur Representative Mercedes "Didi" C. Cagas and father to Vice-Governor Marc Douglas C. Cagas IV, and a committed public servant who devoted his life in the service of the province of Davao del Sur;

WHEREAS, Hon. Dodo Cagas began his political career as an assemblyman in the 1980s. He later on represented then First District of Davao del Sur in the Eleventh (11th), Twelfth (12th), and Thirteenth (13th) Congresses (from 1998 to 2007);

WHEREAS, after his stint in the legislative, he served as the Governor of Davao del Sur first in 2007 until 2013 and again in 2016 until his death;


