**A RESOLUTION
CALLING FOR THE STANDARDIZATION OF QUARANTINE PROTOCOLS FOR ALL
FULLY VACCINATED INDIVIDUALS ENTERING THE PHILIPPINES**

WHEREAS, the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-EID), on June 3, 2021, issued updated guidelines on inbound international travel to any port of the Philippines of all fully vaccinated individuals who have been inoculated in the Philippines;


WHEREAS, under Resolution No. 119, the mandatory facility-based quarantine period for fully vaccinated individuals returning to the country, is shortened from ten (10) days to seven (7) days. Provided that, they present their vaccination cards which must be verified prior their departure from the country;

WHEREAS, the mandatory 14-day quarantine period is quite lengthy and outdated especially since the other countries have introduced shorter quarantine periods;

WHEREAS, with the purpose of lessening the burden placed on fully vaccinated individuals who might be discouraged from visiting the country due to the lengthy facility-based quarantine period, this Representation calls for the application of the shortened mandatory facility-based quarantine period for all inbound fully vaccinated individuals, including those inoculated overseas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the House of Representatives urge concerned agencies to adopt a standardized quarantine protocols for all fully vaccinated individuals entering the Philippines.
