A RESOLUTION
EXPRESSING THE PROFOUND SYMPATHIES AND SINCEREST CONDOLENCES

SUPREME COURT JUSTICE JOSE P. PEREZ

WHEREAS, Retired Supreme Court Associate Justice Jose P. Perez passed away last 12 August 2021 due to an undisclosed illness. He was born on December 14, 1946 and hailed from the City of Batangas;

WHEREAS, He was known to be a homegrown justice since he initially worked in the Judiciary as a Technical Assistant sometime in 1971. Through the years or rather decades of dedicated and excellent work performance he was appointed as Associate Justice on 26 December 2009 and served up to 2016 until he retired from his post;


WHEREAS, He can be recalled to have narrated in a Supreme Court magazine that despite receiving generous and luxurious offers from private firms he still chose to stay in the Supreme Court because his parents were also government employees who spent their lives serving the public so he also chose that path. Some of the positions that he held in the Supreme Court from 1971 were Technical Assisant, Judicial Assistant, Confidential Attorney to Chief Justice Fred Ruiz Castro, Supervising Attorney of the Office of the Chief Attorney, Assistant Chief Attorney, Deputy Court Administrator, Court Administrator and lastly Associate Justice of the Supreme Court;

WHEREAS, his demise and presence will be truly missed in the halls of the Judiciary and the loved ones he left behind as he was an epitome of an upright gentleman who served the nation by promulgating the truth within the bounds of law, justice and equity.
