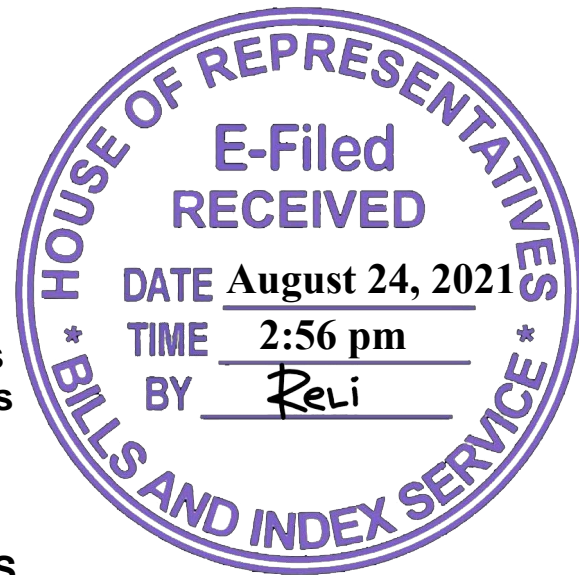

**A RESOLUTION  
EXPRESSING DEEPEST CONDOLENCES OF THE HOUSE OF  
REPRESENTATIVES ON THE DEMISE OF THE HONORABLE  
REPRESENTATIVE HERMINIO SANCHEZ AQUINO**

**WHEREAS**, Former Tarlac Representative Herminio S. Aquino passed away on July 31, 2021 at the age of seventy-two (72) due to esophagus cancer;

**WHEREAS**, Representative Aquino served the 3<sup>rd</sup> district of Tarlac from 1987 to 1998;

**WHEREAS**, Representative Hermie Aquino served as Vice Governor of Tarlac from 1998 to 2001;

**WHEREAS**, Representative Aquino, half-brother of former President Benigno Simeon Aquino Sr., ran as the Vice President of former Senator Raul Roco in the 2004 national elections;

**WHEREAS**, Representative Aquino, prior to his vice presidential bid, served as Deputy Executive Secretary and Minister of the Ministry of Human Settlements from 1986 to 1987 under Former President Cory Aquino;

**WHEREAS**, Representative Aquino was the uncle of the late Sen. Benigno “Ninoy” Aquino Jr. and the great uncle of the late President Benigno “Noynoy” Aquino III.

**WHEREAS**, the death of Representative Herminio S. Aquino on 31 July 2021 came just weeks after the passing of his grand-nephew, Former President Benigno "Noynoy" Aquino III on 24 June 2021 while 1 August 2021 is the commemoration of the 12<sup>th</sup> death anniversary of President Corazon C. Aquino and also marked the the 38<sup>th</sup> death anniversary of Ninoy Aquino on 21 August.

**WHEREAS**, Former Representative Herminio Aquino was survived by his wife, Ma. Victoria Guanzon, and their four (4) children, Servillano II, Paolo Antonio, Ma. Theresa Belinda and Ma. Camille Corazon;

**RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES**, to express its deepest condolences on the demise of Representative Herminio S. Aquino.
