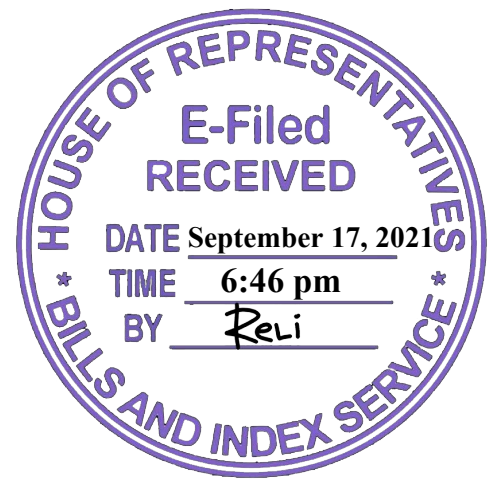

A RESOLUTION

VILLAFUERTE SR. OF CAMARINES SUR

WHEREAS, Luis Villafuerte Sr., passed away last 8 September 2021 at the age of eighty-six (86). He was known to be a political kingpin in the region of Bicol because of his extensive political career and public service for five (5) decades;

WHEREAS, His political stint started in 1978 when he served as an assemblyman and afterwards as a Minister of Trade from 1979 to 1981 under the regime of former President Ferdinand Marcos. He also served as governor of Camarines Sur for a span of fifteen (15) years. He also flourished in being a legislator or lawmaker to further serve the country for the 2nd and 3rd District of Camarines Sur for nine (9) years;

WHEREAS, his profession of being a lawyer having graduated from the University of the Philippines, led him to be remembered as a skillful and competent legislator of his district during congressional hearings. He will be remembered as someone who really took his time to contribute on what needs to be done for our countrymen;


WHEREAS, He is survived by his spouse, Nelly Favis Villafuerte, four (4) sisters, five (5) children and grandchildren;
