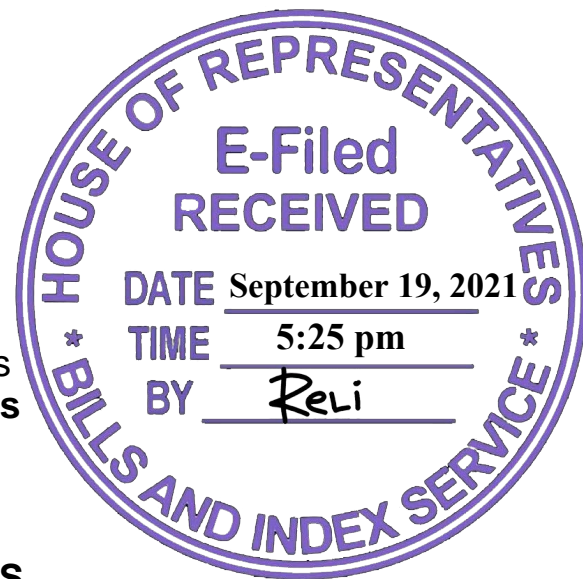

**A RESOLUTION
EXPRESSING DEEPEST SYMPATHIES AND CONDOLENCES OF THE

HONORABLE REPRESENTATIVE EMIL LAO ONG**

WHEREAS, on September 16, 2021, Former Second District, Northern Samar Representative Emil L. Ong died. He was 84 years old.

WHEREAS, Rep. Ong served as the representative of Second District of Northern Samar for three (3) terms, from 2007 to 2016.

WHEREAS, Rep. Ong was a certified public accountant (CPA) and lawyer by profession. He served as delegate in the 1971 Constitutional Convention (ConCon).

WHEREAS, Rep. Ong also served as the Provincial Chairperson of the National Unity Party (NUP).

WHEREAS, during the time of the late President Corazon Aquino, Rep. Ong served in the Executive Department as Administrator of the National Food Authority (NFA).

WHEREAS, the significant feat of Honorable Ong in terms of leadership must be recognized and remembered.

WHEREAS, Rep. Ong is an epitome of a true public servant who touched the lives of most of the people of Northern Samar. He offered his life to serve the Province with utmost dedication and commitment aimed towards the upliftment of the economic status of his constituents.

WHEREAS, Former Representative Emil L. Ong is survived by his son, Northern Samar Governor Edwin Ongchuan, and brother, Former Governor Jun Ong.
