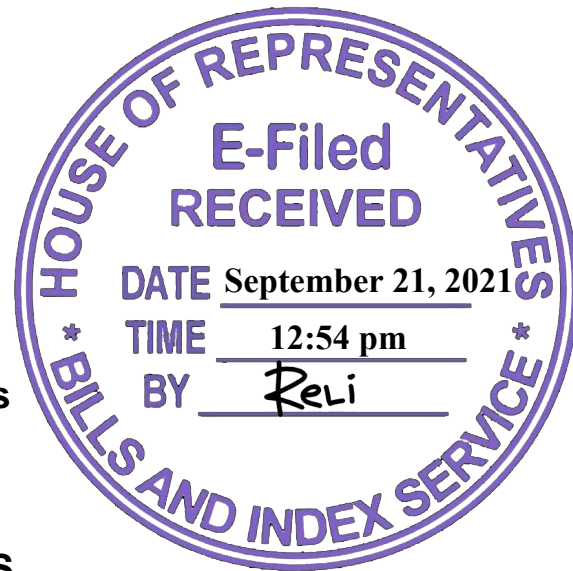

**A RESOLUTION
CONFERRING A CONGRESSIONAL MEDAL OF DISTINCTION TO CARLO
BIADO FOR PREVAILING IN THE 2021 U.S. OPEN POOL NINE BALL
CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT**

WHEREAS, Filipino billiard, Carlo Biado, added another precious hardware to his collection as he lorded over the 256-man field in the US Open Pool Championship in Atlantic City on Saturday, September 18, 2021.

WHEREAS, the 37-year-old Biado became the first Filipino to win this prestigious tournament since Efren “Bata” Reyes in 1994.

WHEREAS, Biado won against Singapore’s Aloysius Yapp with a 13-8 from being down 3-8 then snaring the next ten (10) straight rack .

WHEREAS, Biado started as a caddie at the Villamor Air Base golf course. But at age 14, after watching his father play billiards, he developed interest in the sport.

WHEREAS, determined to become better, he took billiards more seriously at 17 years old and participated in tournaments and money games.

WHEREAS, in 2017, he emerged champion in the World Nine-Ball Championship held in Doha, Qatar and runner-up the following year in the same tournament;

WHEREAS, it is but fitting tribute to Mr. Biado to confer a congressional medal of distinction for this winning the 2021 US Open Pool Nine-Ball Championship tournament.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to confer Mr. Carlo Biado a Congressional Medal of Distinction.

RESOLVED FURTHER, a copy of this Resolution be furnished to Mr. Carlo Biado.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that this Resolution be published in the Official Gazette of the Republic of the Philippines.
