ACT MANDATING THE INTEGRATION OF THE AN NATIONAL BUILDING CODE OF THE PHILIPPINES 6541, ACT NO. UNDER REPUBLIC ACT TO ORDAIN AND INSTITUTE NATIONAL BUILDING CODE OF THE PHILIPPINES". A MAJOR SUBJECT IN THE CURRICULUM THE BACHELOR OF SCIENCE DEGREE PROGRAMS IN CIVIL ENGINEERING, MECHANICAL ENGINEERING, ELECTRICAL ENGINEERING, SANITARY ENGINEERING, ELECTRONICS ENGINEERING, AND ARCHITECTURE, AND ITS INCLUSION AS A TOPIC IN THE LICENSURE EXAMINATIONS FOR THESE **PROFESSIONS**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. This Act shall be known as the "National Building Code Integration Act".

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SEC. 2. It is the policy of the State to safeguard the life, health and property of its citizens and promote public welfare, consistent with the principles of sound environmental management and control embodied in the National Building Code. Towards this end, the State shall ensure that those who practice the engineering and architecture professions shall receive the necessary formal instructions on, learn the latest know-how, regulations and technologies and be sufficiently trained in ensuring the safety and integrity of structures, both building and nonbuilding.

SEC. 3. Pursuant to its mandate under Section 8 of Republic Act No. 7722, otherwise known as the "Higher Education Act of 1994", the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) is mandated to develop and include in the curriculum of the Bachelor of Science degree programs in Civil Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Sanitary Engineering, Electronics Engineering, and Architecture the study of the National Building Code of the Philippines (NBCP) as a major subject in the higher education curriculum of the architecture and engineering courses.

SEC. 4. The Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) is hereby mandated to include the NBCP as a topic in the licensure examinations for the civil engineering, mechanical engineering, electrical engineering, sanitary engineering, electronics engineering, and architecture professions.

SEC. 5. Within ninety (90) days from the effectivity of this
Act, the CHED shall, in consultation with the PRC and other
relevant stakeholders in higher education, promulgate the
implementing rules and regulations necessary to ensure the
efficient and effective implementation of this Act.

SEC. 6. All laws, decrees, provisions of charters, executive orders, ordinances, rules and regulations or other parts thereof contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

SEC. 7. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
